This has a reference to the subject cited above. In this connection, it is stated that -

1. Regarding delay in inspection

- It has been noted that when the Council's Secretariat telephonically contacts the inspectors, they agree for inspection but in some cases neither they conduct the inspection within the scheduled time period nor they intimate the regret for not conducting inspection with reasons therefore to PCI. The Council's Secretariat time and again reminds them telephonically which sometimes leads to inordinate delay in inspection resulting in delay in the grant of approvals.
- Please note that process of grant of approval is a time bound process and the delay in inspection and subsequent delay in grant of approval or otherwise has been viewed seriously by various Courts. The deadlines mentioned in the judgement of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Parshvanath's case has to be complied with in letter and spirit.
- In view of it, 102nd Central Council of the PCI in its meeting held in September, 2017 has decided to warn the inspectors that -
 - refusal of inspection after acceptance or delaying inspection would lead to the removal of their names from the inspectors' panel. In case of litigation on account of delayed or faulty inspection reports, inspectors shall be held responsible and will have to present themselves in the court on their own expenses in case of litigations.
