
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

1. In pursuance of the provisions of Sec.16 of the Pharmacy Act'1948 read with regulation 9 & 18 of Education Regulations-1991 as amended upto date Dr. Ambati Sambasiva Rao & Dr. Nerella Raghunandan, Inspectores of the Council will inspect Diploma Course in Pharmacy conducted at Al-Iqra College of Pharmacy Al-Iqra Education Trust ® Obalapura Post Hosahalli Tumkur-572 106 (Karnataka), on any two mutually decided days immediately to verify adequacy of arrangements for teaching in regard to building, accommodation, equipment, staff, museum & library etc. as specified in Appendix-B of aforesaid Regulations.

2. The inspectors may also attend at any examination held during the inspection period and report on the sufficiency of every examination they attend.

3. The course conducting authority will make available all the original records for actual verification by the inspectors and extend full co-operation.

4. The inspectors may specifically verify the rectification of deficiencies pointed out in the previous inspection report and particularly report the improvements made by the institution. (not applicable in case of first inspection)

5. It was observed that sometimes institutions are declaring holidays at the time of inspection or staff & students are not present at the time of inspection for interaction with inspectors. In view of it, it was decided to inform the institutions that -

i) no holidays shall be declared at the time of inspection and enough opportunities be provided to PCI inspectors for interaction with staff & students at the time of inspection.

ii) in the event, the staff & students are not available at the time of inspection, the inspection will be treated as null & void and re-inspection will be done by the Council at the cost of institution.


iii) to ensure that inspection is done during the working days, institution shall submit its academic calendar with SIF.


Vide circular dt.29.10.2013, the PCI has instructed all the pharmacy institutions as under -

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



This has a reference to the subject cited above. In this connection, it is stated that -

1. Regarding delay in inspection

- a) It has been noted that when the Council's Secretariat telephonically contacts the inspectors, they agree for inspection but in some cases neither they conduct the inspection within the scheduled time period nor they intimate the regret for not conducting inspection with reasons therefore to PCI. The Council's Secretariat time and again reminds them telephonically which sometimes leads to inordinate delay in inspection resulting in delay in the grant of approvals.
- b) Please note that process of grant of approval is a time bound process and the delay in inspection and subsequent delay in grant of approval or otherwise has been viewed seriously by various Courts. The deadlines mentioned in the judgement of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Parshvanath's case has to complied with in letter and spirit.
- c) In view of it, 102nd Central Council of the PCI in its meeting held in September, 2017 has decided to warn the inspectors that -
 - refusal of inspection after acceptance or delaying inspection would lead to the removal of their names from the inspectors' panel. In case of litigation on account of delayed or faulty inspection reports, inspectors shall be held responsible and will have to present themselves in the court on their own expenses in case of litigations.

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
