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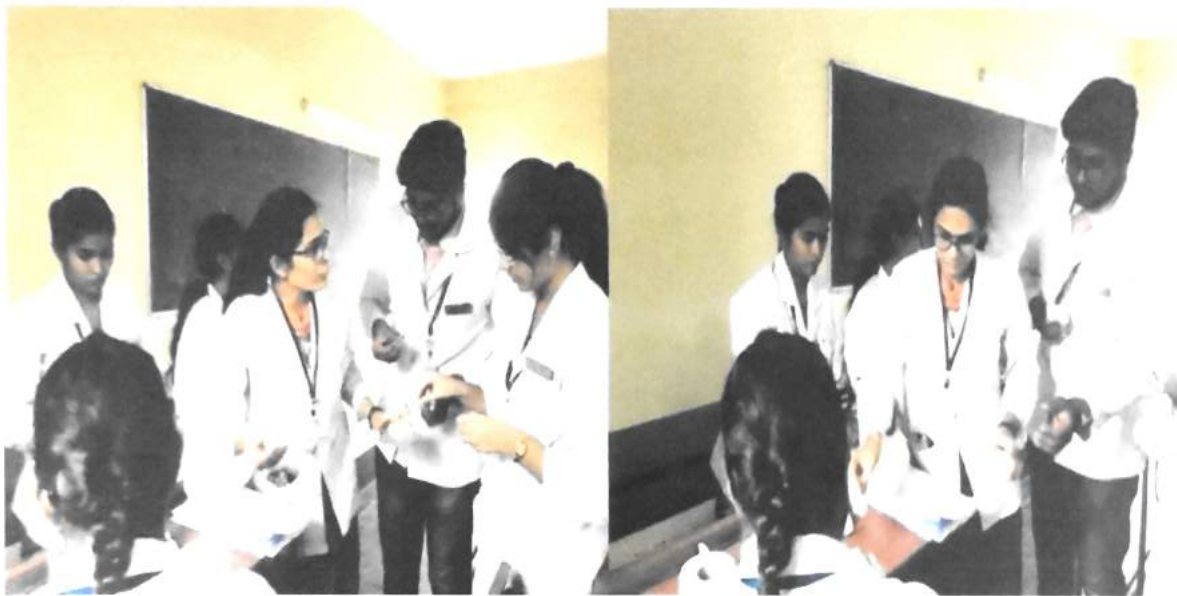


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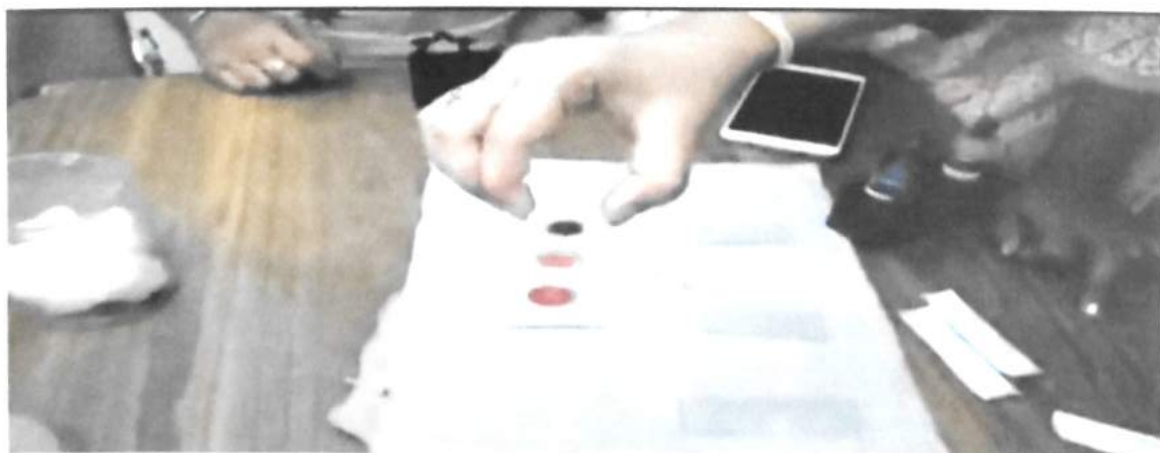

The clinical features include weight gain, moon face, hypertension, and glucose intolerance. The diagnosis is confirmed by a 24-hour urinary free cortisol test.
