






International Yoga Day Celebrations (21/06/2015)






Swatch Bharat Program (24/10/2016)




Plantation program as a part of Haritha Haram (06/07/2016)









Sports day events (06th - 08th Jan 2016)




TRADITIONAL DAY




International Yoga Day celebrations-21st June 2018


Awareness program on Road Safety - 24th July 2018








SANKRANTI CELEBRATIONS




INDEPENDENCE DAY-2018




Personality Development Program- Levels of attraction On orientation programme

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Plantation of Medicinal Plants in the college premises as a part of Haritha


Haram organized by Government of Telangana: 10th OCT 2019
