Functions:

On receipt of any information concerning any reported incident of ragging, the Head of institution shall immediately determine if a case under the penal laws is made out and if so, either on his own or through a member of the Anti-Ragging Committee authorized by him in this behalf, proceed to file a First Information Report (FIR), within 24 hours of receipt of such information or recommendation, with the police and local authorities, under the appropriate penal provisions relating to one or more of the following, namely:

- Abetment to ragging
- Criminal conspiracy to rag
- Unlawful assembly and rioting while ragging
- Violation of decency and morals through ragging
- Injury to body causing hurt or grievous hurt
- Wrongful restraint and Wrongful confinement
- Assault as well as sexual offences or unnatural offences and Extortion
- Attempts to commit any or all of the above-mentioned offences against the victim(s)
